

To whom it may concern,

I am providing the following COVID-19 vaccine exemption for pursuant to Revised Code of Washington (RCW) Section 49.60.030, *Freedom from discrimination – Declaration of civil rights*, which confirms my right to be free from discrimination “because of race, creed, color, national origin, citizenship or immigration status, sex, honorably discharged veteran or military status, sexual orientation, or the presence of any sensory, mental, or physical disability or the use of a trained dog guide or service animal by a person with a disability is recognized as and declared to be a civil right.” RCW Section 49.60.030(1)(a) confirms my “right to obtain and hold employment without discrimination.”

My creed includes “ethical” and “moral” beliefs as defined in Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and represent my “religious” perspective of the world as defined by US Department of Labor in 29 USC 1605.1. Specifically, the DOL defines religion to include “sincerely held religious, ethical, or moral beliefs.” My creed states that my body is mine alone, it is sacred to me, and no one else controls my body or what enters it. My creed keeps me from injecting any other form of medication, vaccination, or substance into my body without my express written consent. Accordingly, I do not consent to allowing the government or any other entity to vaccinate me without my first obtaining my express written consent. Neither the government, its agent, or any actor, may remove, limit, impede, or otherwise inhibit my ability to make choices regarding my own personal medical treatment guided by my creed and beliefs as any such action infringes on my capacity to freely engage in practices protected by RCW 49.60, 29 USC 1605, et. seq., and any other related law.

I hereby attest that I will not violate my creed by consenting to the receipt of the COVID-19 vaccine; nonetheless, I will do everything within my ability that does not violate my personal creed or my rights to help fight this pandemic in my scope of employment as a(n)
